



SPRINT H TANK DESIGN Large capacity enables yo put more miles between g pumps. Has new pebble f plus racing stripe and professional road-racing st



SPRINT SS DETACHABLE LIGHTS — Easy-off headlight and taillight convert any SS to a scrambles track model in minutes.



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
